I don't think that anything was not helpful during this course. • I think that the activities that were the most helpful to me were the weekly excel assignments. I found those to be the most useful in solidifying the information that was taught that week but also in making sure that we understood Excel really well. One of his goals was to make sure that we could all use excel and take the skills that we have learned with us to other things we may need to do in life and I personally think that he succeeded with that. One thing that I found extremely difficult, and is no way the professors fault, was being able to feel like I completely understood the material being taught. I think this is just because the class was taught online. I personally missed the human connection there to make sure that I was paying attention. However, I REALLY appreciated the videos that were used for this course. As far as online classes go this was so incredibly useful. • I really liked the minimicro videos, they were extremely helpful. I think it would have been more helpful to learn about elasticity earlier in the course because some of the earlier readings were from chapters near the middle or end of the book and they referenced it a lot. I think there were a couple of other key concepts like this. Maybe reevaluate the order of some of the key concepts or when certain chapters should be read so that we can easily understand the concepts described in the readings. Overall, I found this to be one of the best online classes I have ever taken from UW. • I really liked the videos. It was a great way to learn the subject and I could pause and rewind to take notes and make sure I understood. I had difficulty going from the videos to the text because the text used other terms to describe and was harder to follow. And it was hard to do assignments/quizzes because it was hard to understand when two sets of terms were used. Consistency would be nice. • Videos are very helpful and make the textbook easier to digest. • You're doing great. • The mini micro videos were always very helpful for me to apply and understand the material from the readings. It was really helpful to have real world examples of how the economic principles I learned can be applied. • This class was very organized, I will give it that. I understand that it is a summer course so it is quicker than other classes, but it felt overwhelming. I did all reading and watched all the videos and tried on all the assignments and I (hopefully) will end with a C. There was just so much going on every week I felt like my brain could not handle it. 3 chapters, 4 videos, 2 online readings, 1 assignment, 1 excel part and 1 quiz was a lot to handle for any student. I also very much disliked how you LOST points if you did not do the calculations in excel. If I got the correct answer why does it matter how I got it. Plus, wouldn't it be better for us to learn how to do it ourselves? Overall, I found this course way harder and way more stressful then it should have been. It is summer and I understand it was my choice to take an online class, but it should not be this difficult. The teacher should understand that we have to work over the summer to afford going to school and we cannot do that if we are stressed about school. • The mini micro videos are awesome. Very helpful. • I think the class as a whole was structured very well. There was just one excel assignment that was a little too long and repetitive . I think it was the second or third. And then the taking in the videos is a little slow. But overall the course was great. • I really liked how in depth his videos were.
